Leadership and Involvement

- During High School, the applicant has, by conduct and activities, demonstrated characteristics of leadership and good citizenship within the high school campus, community and elsewhere
- Must also show a true commitment to service to their school and their community.

Goal

- Applicant must have identified a goal of earning a degree or certification of completion from an accredited institution by satisfying the requirements of a full-time course of study of training.
