A Scholarship for High School Seniors pursuing Science

Johnnie Kohler and her husband were long time residents in Tualatin, Oregon. They lived on a gentleman's farm and she loved and raised animals. She was interested in science and veterinary medicine. Although she and her husband did not have children of their own, it was her desire to help provide a funding source for young people in their pursuit of science studies beyond high school. This scholarship, bearing her name and debuting in the spring of 2003, is an annual scholarship managed by the Foundation for Tigard- Tualatin Schools.

Scholarship Standards

General

- Must be interested in obtaining a degree in agricultural studies, veterinary science or science related major.

Academic

- Must be a graduate of Tigard or Tualatin High School with a minimum accumulated **GPA of at least 2.50** after the **seventh** semester.
- Must be planning to attend college or university.
- Must demonstrate commitment to achieving the highest attainable personal level of academic performance.

Financial

- Applicant's need for financial assistance will be considered amongst all the other items.
- Scholarship is for one year of support in the amount of \$1800.

Leadership and Involvement

- During high school, applicant has, by conduct and activities, demonstrated characteristics of leadership and good citizenship within the high school campus, community and elsewhere
- Must also show a true commitment to service to their school and community.
